PARKING ON THE GROUNDS

\$7.00 per car/per day will be charged for parking on the fairgrounds during **Thursday (beginning at 9 am), Friday, Saturday, and Sunday.** Parking permits will be sold for \$15.00 - the permit is good for parking all days and must be displayed in the vehicle. Parking permits will be **SOLD ON WEDNESDAY** (11am to 8:00 pm) at the Fair Office and at the **GATES ALL DAY THURSDAY AND FRIDAY.**

CAMPING

By action of the St. Croix County Fair, Inc., all persons (18 and under) camping overnight at the fairgrounds will be required to wear wristbands at all times. The cost of the wristband is 50 cents. Camping fees are: \$25.00 per tent, \$35.00 per tent with electricity, \$40 for camper without electricity, \$50.00 for units with electricity, and \$75.00 for units with air conditioning. **Camping registration and further information can be found in the back of the fair book**
