

DEPT. 5 – GOATS

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

All animals exhibiting at the fair must be free of any contagious, infectious or communicable disease.

Goats originating from within Wisconsin: **Sexually-intact goats of any age, and all other goats 12 months of age and older, must be identified with official scrapie ear tags or other official individual identification. Sexually intact goats exposed to scrapie will not be allowed to exhibit.**

Goats originating from outside Wisconsin: **All goats shall be accompanied by a certificate of veterinary inspection. All goats must be identified with official scrapie ear tags or other official individual identification. Goats exposed to scrapie will not be allowed to enter Wisconsin.**

Goats originating from Modified Accredited states (Michigan and Minnesota) must have a permit number and require special tuberculosis testing. Exhibitors should contact the Division of Animal Health at 608-224-4874, well in advance of the fair or exhibition, to determine their testing requirements. All animals for exhibition from Modified Accredited states are required to return directly to the state origin after exhibition.

GENERAL RULES

1. In order to participate in the Showmanship Class and Carcass Evaluation Class the exhibitor needs to sign up on their fair entry form.
2. Limit of 10 animals per exhibitor, including Breeding Stock, Meat Animals, Showmanship and carcass animals with not more than two animals being Market Animals.
3. **Explorers** may exhibit one animal in the Showmanship Class and/or appropriate breeding stock class. The exhibitor must be able to control the animal. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to follow Breeding Stock/Meat Animal rules, clinic and health requirements for the department.
4. While on the fairgrounds all animals must be fitted by the exhibitor, immediate family, another Junior Exhibitor, or a St. Croix 4-H Project Leader. Immediate family is defined as the Exhibitor's parent, brother, sister, step-parent, or legal guardian. If project member does not abide by the rule, the animal is subject to disqualification and will be ineligible for auction or show per discretion of the St. Croix County 4-H/FFA Meat Animal Committee and/or Breeding Stock Committee.
5. All goats must be checked in before penning on Thursday, the second day of the fair. No exceptions. Check in time begins at 9:00 am and concludes at 4:00 pm. All wethers will be weighed in between 11:00 am to 12:00 pm on Thursday the second day of the fair.
6. Any questions please contact a committee member as soon as possible.
7. If only one exhibitor is competing in any class, the judge may recommend any placing at his or her discretion. Judges will not place unworthy entries.
8. Bracing of goats is **allowed** with the understanding that the goat is not lifted or prompted to have the front feet leave the ground.

MARKET WETHERS

Rules:

1. All wethers, must have official scrapie tag or other form of scrapie identification (tattoo).
2. Market wethers will be weighed between 11:00 am to 12:00 pm on Thursday of the fair.
3. Exhibitors may show two market wethers providing they are not in the same weight class.
4. A pen of finished wethers is 2 market wethers only.
5. Current Meat Animal Rules apply to market classes for market animals.
6. Bred and Owned market wether need to have the Dam of the offspring owned and bred by the exhibitor and/or family farm.

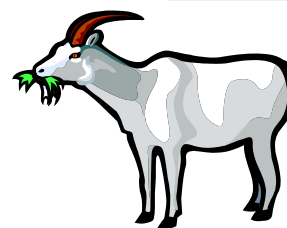
