

DEPT. 9 - DOGS

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

All animals exhibiting at the fair must be free of any contagious, infectious or communicable disease.

Dogs originating from within Wisconsin - Dogs over 5 months of age must have proof of current rabies vaccination.

Dogs originating from outside Wisconsin - All dogs and domestic cats shall be accompanied by a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection and have proof of a current rabies vaccination if the dog or cat is five months old or older. See ATCP 10.80 for specific vaccination information.

The St. Croix County Fair, Inc. **requires** that all dogs over 4 months of age must have a vaccination status that is current for the following diseases:

- Current County Dog project rules apply. Exhibitors must have shown the same dog in an obedience class in order to show it in a showmanship class.

 - Exhibitors must have shown in an obedience class in order to show in a showmanship class
- Premiums, Danish: Blue \$3.00 Red \$2.50 White \$2.00 Pink \$1.50
